CAROLYN'S CAT set a pressured pace along the rail for a half, shook loose to gain a clear advantage in upper stretch then drew away along the fence under steady left hand urging. PORTE BONHEUR away a bit slowly, moved up quickly between horses at the half mile pole, rallied inside on the turn, waited in hand for room nearing the quarter pole, angled between rivals to get clear in upper stretch, lodged a brief move to threaten outside the furlong marker but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the others. ARE WE DREAMIN was under a firm hold along the rail while trailing along the backstretch, moved out on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked a strong closing response. ANY LIMIT pressed the winner from outside to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. GAME FACE was rated just off the early pace, raced in close contention between horses leaving the turn, angled to the outside of ANY LIMIT in upper stretch and faltered in midstretch.
