No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. This race includes an additional \$50,000 in Breeders' Cup Funds for Cup nominees only. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. HOUR GLASS was unhurried while in hand along the backstretch, raced behind horses midway on the turn, split horses in traffic nearing the quarter pole, dove to the rail while rallying in upper stretch, got through along the inside to take the lead nearing the furlong marker, battled into deep stretch and edged clear while drifting out in the late stages. RIGHTLY SO sprinted clear off the rail, set the pace in the two path for a half, came off the rail while drifted out slightly in upper stretch, dug in while battling heads apart into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly while holding narrowly for the place. TAR HEEL MOM stumbled at the start, trailed early, moved out midway on the turn, closed the gap while four wide at the quarter pole, made a run to threaten in midstretch and finished willingly in the middle of the track but could not get up. SAARLIGHT stalked the early pace from outside, lodged a brief three wide bid to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. MALIBU PRAYER was well placed along the rail, raced just behind the leaders while saving ground on the turn and gave way approaching the quarter pole. HOLD THAT PROSPECT pressed the pace in the two path and gave way in upper stretch and was eased late.
