three-eighths pole, dropped back to four wide near the five-sixteenths, split rivals passing the guarter-pole, rallied between horses inside the

furlong marker and closed with a rush to get up in the final stride. TRUE TAILS showed good speed, moved to a clear lead outside the half-mile pole, extended the lead leaving the backstretch, drew off while off the rail on the turn, remained well clear into the final sixteenth but

shortened stride and was caught. COOKIN'S CAST lacked early speed, raced five to six wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. TROLLEY'S LAST was urged along on the inside of FOLLOW THE LITE, raced off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response. KETCHMEWHEREYOUCAN chased the pace, dropped back while four to five wide on the turn and came up empty. TAWNKA settled near the inside, raced just off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. FOLLOW THE LITE was ridden along on the outside of TROLLEY'S LAST,

raced three wide on the turn and faded. ANGEL BABY was ridden along near the middle of the field, raced five wide on the turn and failed to respond. G G'S DOLLY was ridden along while off the pace, lost her stride then dropped back abruptly near the half-mile pole and failed to reach contention. BORN TO DANCE was away alertly from the outside post, chased the pace down the backstretch, broke down near the three-eighths pole and was vanned off.
