1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.40') STAKES. Purse \$125,000 PIN OAK VALLEY VIEW S. (GRADE III) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start, with \$125,000 guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded or group stakes on the turf in 2009 allowed 2 lbs.; \$45,000 twice at a mile or over in 2009, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for The Pin Oak Valley View will be limited to twelve, with two also eligibles. In the event that the race overfills the starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded or group stakes winners, then highest 2009 earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track. (Showery 61)

EYE OF TAURUS stalked the pace three deep, forged a narrow lead entering the stretch, met the challenge of MISS KELLER (IRE) with a furlong to run and held sway through a prolonged battle. MISS KELLER (IRE) settled in hand, launched a bold bid four wide, drew even nearing the furlong marker, kept on well but was unable to best the determined EYE OF TAURUS in the drive. KEERTANA was forwardly placed between horses, came three wide and kept on well to earn the show. AFTERNOON STROLL moved up from between horses, assumed command before going a half, disputed the issue to the stretch and gave way. SENIGA was allowed to settle, came four wide to make a late rally from between horses and improved her position. CUMULONIMBLE contended between horses, angled in entering the stretch but came up empty in the final furlong and faded. HAKA was shuffled back entering the first turn, settled into stride at the tail of the field, swung six wide to make a belated gain but was never a factor. FOREST UPROAR settled in the second flight toward the inside and failed to respond. UNBRIDLED ESSENCE was unhurried into stride, angled out to be clear, raced wide throughout and was never a factor. AURORA LIGHTS angled in and closed the gap along the inside down the backstretch, but came up empty leaving the second turn and retreated. DIRECT LINE opened clear to set the early pace, was collared before going a half, stayed on well to the stretch and stopped.
