Bred by Adena Springs(ON) PRIVATE ZONE kicked clear of the competition after the start to take control, took up position in the two path being rated along while cutting the pace, arrived at the quarter pole sensing intensified pressure and was asked for run, had the runner up draw alongside by the end of the run through the furlong grounds, was still locked in a spirited tussle with that opponent when he drifted out slightly, just at the chief nemesis was leaning inward at the same, resulting in light contact between the twosome, went onward for couple of more jumps, came out a second time, this occurring after a solid solitary shot from the left side, bumped solidly with JUSTIN PHILLIP, then dug in gamely to cross the wire first. JUSTIN PHILLIP was rated between rivals in the two path within striking distance, picked up interest when asked to nearing the end of the bend, bumped with THE LUMBER GUY as that duo spun into the lane, closed in readily during the ensuing furlong to latch on to the winner, whittled away at the advantage and appeared to poke a head down in front in the vicinity of the sixteenth, bumped twice with PRIVATE ZONE afterwards, with the previously-mentioned rival bearing more responsibility for the second incident, continued onward with good courage but couldn't go by again. STRAPPING GROOM patiently tracked the top one from the pocket, got angled outward after entering the stretch in preparation to try and split the front runners, wasn't up to the task at hand and weakened. FORTY TALES rode the rail on the backstretch, abandoned it in time for the run around the bend, commenced the stretch three wide, mustered up a mild response to improve position belatedly. BAHAMIAN SQUALL raced three to four wide on the bend and had no rally. CANDYMAN E tossed his head up and got away awkwardly, was sent over to the inside coming to the end of the backstretch, cut the corner into the stretch, had no offering. THE LUMBER GUY chased three wide on the turn, bumped with the second place finisher as the pair headed into the stretch, began to back away shortly afterwards. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run before the result was declared official. In addition, a claim of foul lodged
