Bay Gelding, (Apr), by Macho Uno - Auburn Beauty by Siphon (BRZ). Trainer Velazquez Alfredo. Bred by Adena Springs(ON). PRIVATE ZONE hooked up a duel with HAPPY MY WAY right after the start, disputed the pace towards the three path, rider keeping something in reserve all the while, moved when ready as the half was being consummated and displaced the aforementioned rival, himself having been put to a drive, was almost at the eighth pole when asked for a response, the runner up lurking a major danger to the outside at this juncture, dug in gamely to fend off an equally-determined foe. DADS CAPS sat reserved behind the front runners while loosely drafting behind one of them to the five-sixteenths marker, got angled into the three path departing that station, entered the stretch and was set down, closed enough ground during the run through the furlong grounds to loom boldly by the end of the it, showed good determination but couldn't go by. PALACE rode the rail for nearly a half, angled out four wide from the quarter pole, gained ground gradually en route for show honors. SALUTOS AMIGOS off the inside, picked up interest when asked to as the half was being completed, spun four wide into upper stretch, under strong encouragement, mustered up a mild response. COUP DE GRACE three wide midpoint on the turn, commenced the stretch a couple of paths wider, lacked the needed response. HAPPY MY WAY sparred with the winner from the two path, relinquished despite getting called upon nearing the quarter pole. RIBO BOBO strung out four wide at the three-eighths pole, was never involved. ZEE BROS lunged coming out the starting gate, knocking the rider slightly off balance for the first few jumps, raced three to four wide on the turn, gave way.
