By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination. A Supplementary Nomination of \$3,000 may be made on Saturday, August 24, 2013, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHTS: Sunday, August 25, 2013. This event will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference will be Highweights (on the scale). \*Total Earnings in 2013 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees with the exception of the nominating fee(s). Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations Closed Wednesday, August 21, 2013 with 12. (Cloudy 74)

 WILLCOX INN was settled into stride outside foes tracking the leaders from out of striking distance in the opening half, gradually gathered momentum racing four deep into the second bend, continued with a steady response while shifting inwards racing into upper stretch moving to challenge for command, then continued in a protracted skirmish to late stages but just prevailed on the wire under strong right handed encouragement. GALLANT EAGLE (IRE) was urged to secure the lead while angling to the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin into the second bend, turned back several challengers to maintain the lead into upper stretch, then grudgingly resisted the winner to the end. HATTAASH, reserved avoiding tight quarters just after the start, tracked the leaders along the inside from just out of striking distance racing to the far turn, saved ground on the second bend, shifted off the inside racing through the stretch to challenge the leaders three deep in the closing stages and continued willingly to the end to narrow the gap. MISTER MARTI GRAS tracked the leaders leading the second flight just off the inside racing into the backstretch, was urged to advance three deep between foes on the far turn to lodge a brief bid, but was shuffled out close quarters leaving the quarter mile marker and had no further response. AGENT DI NOZZO, reserved last just off the inside racing to the far turn, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch while being urged to advance but made no real impression. COLOR ME BLUE, forwardly placed along the inside racing into the first, shifted out tracking just off the leader racing to the second bend, made a brief bid between foes after six furlongs but steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
