1 MILE. (1.321) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 WESTCHESTER S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 may be made at closing time of entries; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. All entrants will be required to pay entry and start fees. The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any horse that competes in both the Westchester and Metropolitan Hcp will have their entry fee waived for the Metropolitan Hcp. Three year olds, 118.; Older 123. Non-winners of \$60,000 in 2010 allowed 2 lbs.; Non winners of a graded sweepstakes since October 1, 2009, 4 lbs.; 4 races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming, Starter and Restricted allowance races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday April 17, 2010 with 35 Nominations. (Clear 74)

LE GRAND CRU away from the gate in good order, patiently prompted the pacesetter from the two path during the initial half, was asked for run after entering the turn, drew alongside the leader briefly at the midway point, was shaken off turning for home, rallied back under a drive, forged to the front and edged away. CONVOCATION pursued the fraction setter three wide, advanced to reach a good striking position after being roused on the turn, continued on willingly, proved no match for the top one but continued on to the wire willingly to win the place photo. IRONMAN JON rated on the pace towards the inside until the quarter pole, was outkicked during the final furlong. HONEST MAN saved ground and displayed a mild rally. BRIBON (FR) rank between steadied along down the backstretch, was guided over to the four path, ranged up along the outside, only to flatten out after entering the stretch. PAST THE POINT had no rally. MORE THAN A REASON was never in contention. GIANT MOON saved ground to no avail.
