Dark Bay or Brown Mare, (May), by Majestic Warrior - Terra Maria by Citidancer. Trainer Graham L. Robin. Bred by Mrs. Frank P. Wright(KY).

LADY SABELIA , a forward factor in the three path between horses down the backstretch, was rated back approaching the turn, swung out entering the bend, circled horses five deep, swept to command at the head of the lane and was put to a serious drive approaching the eighth pole. SHE'S ORDAINED advanced four deep entering the turn, gained a short lead approaching the stretch, lost the lead entering the stretch then gamely chased the winner. SOUNDS OF THE CITY lacked speed, saved ground around the turn, angled to the three path in upper stretch and rallied mildly. DISCO BARBIE circled the turn, was five deep turning for home and passed tired horses. VICKI'S DANCER prompted the pace two wide between horses and gave way in mid stretch. WINNING IMAGE sped to the early lead, set the pace in the three path, failed to keep pace leaving the turn and retreated through the stretch. FLATTERING BEA , sent early, hugged the rail, chased the pace, gave way entering the stretch and swung out in upper stretch.
