GET FUNKY sped to the early lead outside foes, angled in and set the pace inside, fought back on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and weakened some late. SILENT SOUL chased between horses, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TIZ WEST pulled a bit and stalked inside, came out into the stretch, went between horses in midstretch,

PRUSSIAN pulled a bit early, stalked outside a rival, was between horses leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. GENERALITO NAIN (ARG) saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. AITCHO settled off the pace just out from the inside, dropped well back, trailed throughout and was outrun.
