**6 FURLONGS. (1.072) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 WINNING COLORS S.(GRADE III) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three year olds, 118 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes in 2008 allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 twice in 2007-2008, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming since October 27, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, May 10, 2008 with 16 nominations. (Cloudy 79)**

**GRAEME SIX** pressed the pace four wide, drew clear in midstretch and stayed clear under steady urging. **MISS MACY SUE** bumped after breaking slowly, angled out, moved up quickly to a forward position before a quarter, raced five wide around the turn and lodged a mild bid for the place. **CHANGE UP** set the pace off the inside and held on gamely when displaced. **GEM SLEUTH** reserved off the inside, angled out three wide late on the turn but lodged only a mild late bid. **PRETTY JENNY** bumped **ADHRHYTHM** at the start, raced close up three wide and weakened. **ADHRHYTHM** bumped at the start, was forwardly placed along the inside and tired.
