SWEET CASSIOPEIA bobbled at the start, settled between horses, was jostled sharply near the five-eighths pole, lost position and showed little thereafter. ANAHAUC was allowed to settle between horses, was caught in tight and bumped with SWEET CASSIOPEIA with five furlongs to run and was never a factor from that point on.
