Bay Colt, (Apr), by Lemon Drop Kid - Kreisleriana by Seeking the Gold. Trainer Brown C. Chad. Bred by Scott C. Heider & Knowles Bloodstock, Inc. (KY).

BALANCE THE BOOKS was taken in hand early, dropped to the rear, lagged at the back while unhurried and off the inside, remained patient while still at the back on the far turn, shifted four wide and was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, swung six wide into the stretch, bumped with HIGHTAIL just as they straightened which tipped him into the seven path, rallied on the outside, gained his best stride in the final furlong and closed strongly to get up near the wire. JOHA moved to the lead nearing the first turn, went two to three wide on that bend, was well rated while setting a clear pace, responded well when asked near the five-sixteenths pole, raced off the hedge turning into the stretch, extended the advantage into the final furlong, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was denied near the wire. CHARMING KITTEN showed early foot while amongst horses, allowed JOHA to take the lead nearing the first turn, was rated while close to the inside, chased inside after being asked on the far turn, shifted off the hedge at the top of the stretch, pursued the winner under the whip into the final furlong then finished willingly but lacked a winning kick and settled for the show. NOTACATBUTALLAMA went three wide while between horses on the first turn, was taken up a bit just after straightening onto the backstretch, moved to the outside and settled in that position, was asked while three to four wide on the far turn, came under an all out drive in upper stretch and also lacked the needed kick. HE'S SO FINE settled along the hedge, came under some urging approaching the seven-sixteenths pole, saved ground on the far turn, cut the corner while put to a drive into the stretch, came under the whip and lacked the needed response. HIGHTAIL went four wide early on the first turn then tucked into the three path, settled outside on the backstretch, was asked while three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, bumped with BALANCE THE BOOKS at that point, moved in while under a drive near the furlong marker and also lacked the needed response. ALMOST AN ANGEL was taken under a strong hold on the initial straightaway, steadied off heels late on the first bend, was reserved near the middle of the field while off the hedge, came under urging on the far turn, shifted four wide at the top of the stretch, got carried in while under the whip near the furlong marker, was taken in hand outside the sixteenth-pole and failed to rally. CRAVING CARATS was taken under a tight hold while pulling early, raced between rivals while in tight quarters on the first turn, was taken up some when NOTACATBUTALLAMA did the same early on the backstretch, dropped towards the rear, waited near the back on the far turn, was caught behind a rival turning into the stretch then was finally given free rein and also failed to rally. BERNIE THE JET was caught four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased while off the inside on the far turn and gave way.
