BASHART broke on top, was put to a good hold cutting the pace from the inside, with another pair making their presence felt, parked out in paths two and three, was let out a notch as the third fraction was being recorded when they issued a challenge for command, repulsed their bids in short order, spun into the stretch and got asked for his best, responded positively to arrive a furlong down the road still the clear leader, continued onward with good determination and under good handling to fend off the late challenge coming from RIVER DANCER to prove best. RIVER DANCER contently took the inside route, picked up interest when asked to leaving the five-sixteenths pole, angled sharply five wide in upper stretch, leaning upon with some force and taking TIGER BOURBON along for a short ride while doing so, started to close in upon resuming a truer course, drifted inward in the late stages while continuing to cut into the top one's margin, failed to reel the winner in, but won the fight for second, then was vanned off after crossing the finish line. MARVIN'S MIRACLE fighting with force on the bit, sneaked his way into the pocket coming to the end of the homestretch, settled down soon afterwards, contently tracked the front runners, without applying pressure during the initial stages, began to pick up the pace and some real estate past the midway point on the second bend, was given his cue for the stretch and gained ground readily, altered course to be outside the winner in the vicinity of the sixteenth marker, failed to make up any more ground while getting outfinished for place honors as well. TIGER BOURBON chased the leader from the two path, was under a drive spinning four to five wide into upper stretch, brushed with the runner up and got herded out soon afterwards, then backed away. BASE CASE SCENARIO three wide heading for the opening bend, cleared TIGER BOURBON and worked out a tuck into the two path in time for the start of the run around it, contested the pace from between rivals for three-quarters, was asked for run and launched an abbreviated bid for command at the five-sixteenths pole, had it quickly negated and gave way. WE MISS ARTIE forwardly placed in the three path, disputed the issue as the widest of a threesome for six furlongs, tired. RACETRACK ROMANCE raced along the outside and was outrun.
