1½ MILE. (Turf) (1:49) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 Wonder Again SINNER TURF FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. The first two finishers of the Wonder Again will receive an automatic invitation to the Grade One Belmont Oaks on Saturday, July 4th. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$90,000 twice at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; of \$60,000 at a mile or over allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race allowed 8 lbs. A presentation to be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf the first two finishers will not receive an automatic invitation to the Belmont Oaks. Closed Saturday, May 16, 2015 with 33 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (Rail at 35 feet). (Clear 80)

LADY ELI away in good order, took up position in midpack from off the inside, sat reserved in the two path, was between rivals for most of the run around the far turn, was kept on hold, stuck behind rivals and lacking suitable options approaching the quarter pole, idled in the same traffic situation after turning for home, lightly hand urged to maintain interest, espied an opening towards the outside nearing the end of the furlong grounds, angled sharply towards to, gaining the freedom necessary to launch a rally, did so, outfinished a pair of foes to her inside in the final stages, lightly hand ridden, to prove best. HEATH assumed a prominent spot after the start, prompted the pace from the two path, rider holding something back in reserve, continued along under the same scenario all the way to the quarter pole, got asked for more for the drive home, vied with vigor against PINE NEEDLES, had the winner arrive on the scene in deep stretch, gamely fought from between those two in the last jumps en route for place honors. PINE NEEDLES broke well and established command once the other alert breaker, that being PANGBURN, got taken back early on the clubhouse turn, cut over to the rail, was rated cutting the pace, with the runner up in close attendance parked out in the two path, came under heavier pressure from that opponent heading for the top of the lane, got set down to a hard drive, yielded reluctantly to the top twosome in the shadow of the wire. ITSONLYACTINGDAD bumped early with PUCA, saved ground to upper stretch, mustered up a mild response after getting angled outward. MY SWEET GIRL had the pilot grab hold after breaking a few paths to the outside, raced three wide on both turns, lacked the necessary stretch response. MISS CHATELAINE three wide on the first turn, remained off the inside, had no rally. PUCA bumped early with PANGBURN, swung two wide into the backstretch, continued from off the rail and failed to menace. PANGBURN taken back on the first turn, faltered off the subsequent ground-saving journey.
