5½ FURLONGS. (Turf) (1.013) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 WOODFORD S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 guaranteed, of which \$60,000 to the owner of the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth and \$2,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: Three year olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes on the turf in 2010 allowed 2 lbs; \$36,000 twice since February 14, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 since April 23, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Woodford will be limited to twelve, two also eligibles. In the event that the race overfillst he starters will be determined with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2009-2010 earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, September 29, 2010 with 30 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Six Furlongs on the main track. (Clear 78)

Gray or Roan Gelding, (Apr), by Prime Timber - River Princess by Alwuhush. Trainer Brown C. Chad. Bred by Sez Who Thoroughbreds(NY).

SILVER TIMBER reserved four wide while within reach of the lead, angled out a bit for a clear path in upper stretch and closed well to be up in time. CENTRAL CITY a bit uncoordinated at the start, rushed to the lead, set a fast pace, responded when challenged on the turn, drew clear in midstretch and held on gamely but was outfinished. DUE DATE outrun early, commenced his rally in the four path on the turn then closed well on the outside to be steadily getting to the top pair late. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE sluggish at the start, was outrun early, raced five wide on the turn then finished well late. RAVALO reserved along the inside, moved closer after three furlongs, came out between rivals near the sixteenth marker after YANKEE INJUNUITY angled in and was gaining late. GREAT ATTACK outrun for three furlongs four wide, made a good late gain. YANKEE INJUNUITY within striking distance along the inside, moved off the rail for the drive, drifted in approaching the sixteenth marker then lacked a late bid. ATTA BOY ROY prominent four wide, stayed on well to inside the final furlong and weakened. IN MY CORNER within striking distance three wide, angled out for the drive but lacked a late bid. FIDDLERS PATRIOT forced the pace three wide, held on to the stretch and tired. CALIFORNIA FLAG prompted the pace off the inside and faded in the drive.
