1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.461) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 **WOODFORD RESERVE TURF CLASSIC S. (GRADE I) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD.** By subscription of \$100 each on or before February 13, 2010 or by Supplementary Nomination of \$25,000 each at the time of entry. \$2,500 to pass the entry box; \$2,500 additional to start with \$500,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three-year-olds 117 lbs. Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade or Group I or II stakes at a mile or over since November 6, 2009 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade or Group I or II stakes at a mile or over since October 1, 2009, 5 lbs.; a graded or group stakes at a mile or over in 2009-2010, 7 lbs. All supplementary nominations are required to pay the entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner given by Woodford Reserve. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with the American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Saturday, February 13, 2010 with 81 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Eighth mile.). (Rainy 68)

Gray or Roan Colt, (Mar), by Sky Mesa - Ecology by Unbridled's Song. Trainer McCarthy R. Thomas. Bred by Mr. & Mrs. R. David Randal(KY).

GENERAL QUARTERS was reserved off of the pace under a tight hold, launched his bid three wide, drew even entering the stretch, dug in gamely to meet the challenge of COURT VISION, fought on through a prolonged drive and was fully extended to narrowly prevail. COURT VISION was allowed to settle in the second flight three wide, ranged into striking distanced through the second turn, came four wide and poked his head in front with a furlong to run, battled between horses but grudgingly gave way late. LOUP BRETON (IRE) broke awkwardly nearly unseating his jockey, recovered quickly and moved into contention three wide, angled to the inside entering the backstretch, waited in traffic entering the stretch, angled out to find room, split horses inside the furlong marker and was making up ground once clear. BATTLE OF HASTINGS (GB) settled saving ground, closed the gap quickly along the hedge through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch, was bottled up between rivals near the three-sixteenths pole, was bumped and stuffed in behind GENERAL QUARTERS with a furlong to run, worked his way back to the outside and kept on well despite trouble. BLUES STREET was unhurried into stride, made a steady advance circling seven wide but found his best stride too late. AL KHALI was forwardly placed three wide, but faltered between horses in the final furlong and faded. YATE'S BLACK CAT contended three wide through the second turn and dropped out. WISE RIVER opened clear to dictate terms, was collared nearing the quarter pole and gave way readily once headed. POP TARRT was shuffled back between horses early and showed little thereafter.
