Any horse that competes in both the Whitney H. and the Woodward will have their entry fee waived for the Woodward. Weights for age. Three-year-olds, 121 lbs.; older, 126 lbs. The estate of Mrs. William Woodward, Sr. to add the Woodward C challenge Cup, to be won three times, not necessarily consecutively, by the same owner before becoming his or her property. RACHEL ALEXANDRA drifted out a bit while moving up to contest the pace on the first turn, moved up in hand while well off the rail to take the lead before going a half mile, set a rapid pace while being pressured from both sides for five furlongs, opened a clear advantage nearing the three-eighths pole, extended her lead a bit under strong urging in upper stretch, dug in when challenged inside the sixteenth pole, fought gamely under steady right hand encouragement into deep stretch and was fully extended to hold off MACHO AGAIN in the closing strides.

MACHO AGAIN dropped far back for a half, raced in hand while trailing for six furlongs, closed the gap along the inside to reach contention on the turn, split horses while gaining at the top of the stretch, made a sustained move to threaten leaving the furlong marker then closed steadily through the final seventy yards but could not get up. BULLSBAY was reserved along the inside for a half, split horses while gaining on the turn, made a move between horses to threaten in upper stretch and weakened under pressure in the final eighth. ASIATIC BOY (ARG) pressed the pace from outside along the backstretch, lodged a brief bid on the turn, drifted five wide at the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. IT'S A BIRD raced in midpack for six furlongs, lodged a mild move four wide on the turn and flattened out. PAST THE POINT pressed the early pace from outside, lodged a brief bid from outside on the far turn, drifted six wide entering the stretch and gave way. COOL COAL MAN raced just off the pace along the inside, lodged a mild bid on the turn and flattened out. DA' TARA dueled inside the winner for five furlongs and gave way and was eased late.
