HIBAAYEB (GB) a bit slow to begin, raced four wide in the chute then angled in and stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, bid three wide in the drive, gained the lead in late stretch and gamely prevailed under a crack of the whip and good handling. TURNING TOP (IRE) prompted the pace outside a rival, battled between horses in midstretch, put a head in front past the eighth pole, fought back between foes through the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. GYPSY'S WARNING (SAF) sped to the early lead, inched away briefly past the wire the first time, set a pressured pace inside, fought back through the stretch and also continued willingly to hold third. SWEET AND FLAWLESS angled in and chased outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. RESTLESS SOUL (GB) chased inside then a bit off the rail, went between horses on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. PRINCESS TAYLOR (GB) angled in and stalked the pace inside, continued along the rail on the second turn and in the stretch and also lacked the necessary late response. PRINCESS HAYA chased outside then alongside a rival, came out into the stretchy and did not rally. GO FORTH NORTH broke a bit slowly, settled inside then a bit off the rail, angled inward again in the stretch and was not a threat.
