The \$50,000 Guaranteed to be divided; \$30,000 to the winner, \$10,000 to second, \$5,500 to third, \$3,000 to fourth and \$1,500 to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 120 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. OPEN MEADOWS vied for the lead while three wide, was in a long hard sustained drive and drew off in deep stretch to prove best.

GRANDMA W. vied for the lead while inside, was in a long sustained drive along the inside and gamely dug in but hung in deep stretch while still being second best. **KATHY'S ROCKET** was between rivals on the backstretch while well placed, saved ground coming out of the turn and made a bid to finish well in late stretch. **SO SORRY** was settled then rallied five wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground to finish well in late stretch. **COOKIN'S CAST** made a strong five wide middle move on the turn then raced evenly in the stretch. **MADAME MENEHUNE** was settled then made a mild rally in the stretch but was no threat in late stretch. **FRESA MARGARITA** vied for the lead while three wide, was hard used throughout and weakened in late stretch. **EXPECTANT DIVA** raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. **CRESCENT LAKE** raced on the inside on the turn and was no factor. **ANNIE SAVOY** saved ground on the turn then faltered in late stretch.
